Fees: MAD Instructors: \$55.00, MKC Members: \$82.00, General Public, \$110.00

Fees are payable by Check, Electronic payment sent using Zelle only, and Instructor MAD money.

A complete registration package includes a completed, signed and legible registration from, a current rabies certificate and payment.

For payment through Zelle, payment information once a spot in the class is verified. Once notified a spot is available in the class, payment must be made within three days to hold the spot.

A complete registration includes a completed and signed registration form, current rabies certificate, and payment. If the registrar has a valid rabies certificate on file, a new one need not be supplied.

Administrative details:

Dogs must be at least twelve months old at the start of the class. Because growth plates have not closed, handlers are cautioned to not attempt full jump heights or full height contacts until the dog is at least 18 months old. Those with larger breeds should consider waiting even longer. Note our instructors are aware of the dogs ages and will be looking out for this. Obedience training is desired, such as a recall and 30 second stay.

Students new to Mattaponi who started their agility training elsewhere and want to enroll in Intermediate I Intermediate II or Advanced need an evaluation. (Title certificates for AKC Novice or equivalent may be submitted in lieu of going to an evaluation.) Contact the registrar to determine when the evaluation will be conducted.

Registration

1. Complete the form and either email (<u>becky1grant@verizon.net</u>) an image of it to the registrar or send it to the registrar via regular mail to Becky Grant 9430 Waterford Dr. Manassas, VA 20110. Registration is not complete without a signed registration form, current rabies form and payment. (For those electing to pay via Zelle, send the registration and rabies certificate via email and the registrar will contact you with payment information.) Forms that are not legible will be returned unprocessed this include electronic filled form completed in small type.

Rabies Certificates:

1. The dog must have a current rabies certificate on file with the registrar. The registrar holds on to certificates for the current calendar year only. If you are new to MKC classes or your certificate expires prior to the end of a class session, a new one must be provided. Certificates may be sent via email or with a paper registration form.

Payment

- 1. You may opt to pay for classes with a check, MKC workers coupons from an MKC agility trial, or, for instructors, MAD money. If paying by check, it must be included with the registration by mail.
- 2. You may also pay electronically using Zelle. The registrar will provide instructions once your space in the class is confirmed.

Fees: General Public, \$110.00; Mattaponi Kennel Club Members \$82.00; Junior handlers, \$55.00; MAD Instructors \$55.00. Junior handlers are those younger than 18.

Bitch in season (BIS): are only allowed to run in the Advanced class wearing properly fitted panties. Aggressive dogs will be removed from class.

Refunds as follows: If you withdraw within the first three weeks of class, you will receive a refund as indicated below. If your dog becomes sick or injured, or comes into season at any point in class, you will receive a prorated refund for missed classes as follows providing a veterinarian's note is provided. If you are asked to leave class for failure to control your dog or aggressive behavior, you are also entitled to a prorated refund for any remaining classes. You must contact the registrar to request a refund.

Refunds are calculated as follows: The fee paid is divided by six (the total number of classes in the session) and your refund will be the per class rate for each class remaining. Refunds are given in kind, if you paid using MAD money (for instructors only) or worker coupons earned at an agility trial, the appropriate amount will be returned to you.
